July Strasbourg Update from Stuart Agnew MEP

The Parliament voted through a legislative bill (A8-0227/2017). This is part of a wider agenda to take ultimate control of taxation, introduce wealth taxes and challenge existing tax residency.

At the beginning of the week, the President of the European Commission, Jean-Claude Juncker, accused the Parliament of being "ridiculous". The Parliament proved the point two days later when votes were taken at such an incredible speed that we could not keep up. Please see video at:-
