June Strasbourg Update from Stuart Agnew MEP

The Parliament voted in favour of asking the Commission to use EU funds to fight against Euroscepticism (A8-0202/2017).

Should this come about, British taxpayers will pay more than their fair share.

The Green lobby are still determined to ban the herbicide Glyphosate (Roundup). I gave a speech in its favour, which can be viewed at:-

With the help of a German MEP (Albert Dess) I was able to force a vote which, had it succeeded, would have prevented the Commission from bringing in legislation that would make it more difficult for farmers to grow legume crops. However, we lost by six votes (more voted for this than against, but a 'qualified majority' was required that we didn't quite reach.)
