The Parliament voted to require Member States to pass on information to the EU about the tax affairs of their own citizens (A8-0326/2016).

We had two Defence Reports to vote on, on different days. Both passed easily. If anyone doubts that the EU is trying to create its own army, please think again.

Despite the fact that the Commission has no competence over forestry policy, it is pressing ahead anyway to create one. I spoke against this power grab.

The Parliament voted to frustrate the re-approval of a herbicide that has been used safely in the UK for very many years.
